

## South Asian Earthquake Relief – Oct. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2005

At 0855 hours on Saturday October 8, 2005, Pakistan was struck by the worst ever earthquake in its history with a magnitude of 7.6 on the Richter scale. The earthquake affected the Northern area of Pakistan, causing human damages at an unprecedented level.



- Over 73,000 Confirmed deaths
- Over 70,000 injured and physically disabled
- Over 4 million displaced and thousands still missing
- Nearly half the victims of earthquake were children under the age of 18

- Nearly 1 million children of school age have been affected
- Over 450,000 children between 5 and 9 years need primary education.



- Nearly 8,000 schools destroyed
- Nearly 4,000 temporary schools needed
